## **KW|AG Offers New Adult Workshops**

January 25, 2008 - *Kitchener, ON* -- The Kitchener-Waterloo Art Gallery (KW|AG) invites adults in the Kitchener-Waterloo and neighbouring communities to participate in two new art workshops designed especially for adults.

### **Printmaking with Amy Roger – February 2, 2008**

On Saturday, February 2 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. Amy Roger will conduct a beginner level *Printmaking* workshop introducing two forms of printmaking: screen and collograph printing. In screen printing, participants will design a stencil, and use a silk screen to transfer their image onto paper and fabric pieces. With collograph printing, a kind of collage printmaking, students will create a textured template using found materials, and then transfer this onto paper using a press.

Amy Roger holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Syracuse University as well as a post-graduate degree in Museum Studies from San Francisco State University. Amy uses oils, acrylics, encaustic wax and glass to create visually stimulating and expressive works. Her work can be seen in museums, galleries and private collections in Canada, US, and Mexico.

### **Drawing with Ann Marie Hadcock – March 1, 2008**

On Saturday, March 1 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. Ann Marie Hadcock will lead a beginner level *Drawing* workshop, engaging participants to experiment with pencil, charcoal, conté and pastels.

Ann Marie Hadcock is an installation artist who has experience with both painting and drawing. She holds a Masters of Fine Art degree from the University of Windsor, an Honours Visual Arts degree from the University of Western, and a Fine Art Diploma from Fanshawe College. Ann's practice and teaching approach focuses on the freedom to experiment with materials and techniques in a relaxed playful environment.

The cost for each workshop is \$20 which includes all materials. Classes take place at the Gallery located at 101 Queen Street North in Kitchener.
